WHAT IS RIOT?

RIOT is a three-day experience for incoming 6th-12th grade students where they will learn how to go deeper in their relationship with Jesus. RIOT will take place June 25-27 from 9:00am-1:00pm for middle school and 5:30pm-9:30pm for high school. We will have incredible worship, relevant teachings, in-depth breakout sessions, and awesome activities.

WHAT IS RIOT RALLY?

RIOT Rally takes place during all student services the week or weekend before RIOT. This is when your student will pick up all their gear, so make sure to get them there.

DO STUDENTS NEED TO BRING EXTRA MONEY?

There will be snacks available for purchase from the café throughout the event, and food trucks will be available starting at 11:30am for middle school and 4:30pm for high school.

CAN STUDENTS BRING CELL PHONES?

Students may bring a cell phone to contact parents or to take pictures only. However, you assume all risk if lost, broken, or taken.

CAN MY STUDENT DRIVE TO THE EVENT?

Licensed drivers may drive themselves to the Riverside location.

WHAT MEALS WILL BE PROVIDED?

Food trucks will be available with food for purchase.

IS THIS AN OVERNIGHT EVENT?

Students will not be staying overnight for RIOT. Parents are responsible for the drop-off and pick-up of their student at the beginning and conclusion of the event.

DOES MY STUDENT HAVE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL ACTIVITIES?

Attendance generally infers participation. If a student is physically limited, other arrangements can be made. Students are expected to participate in the main services and breakout sessions by listening, having a good attitude, contributing to the discussion times, and interacting with others.

WHAT IF MY STUDENT ARRIVES LATE OR LEAVES EARLY?

Arrangements for these types of cases need to be communicated to and cleared by the student pastor at your location prior to the RIOT. No fees will be refunded in such cases.

WHAT ABOUT MY STUDENT'S PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION?

There will be a nurse on site all three days. However, your student will be responsible for their medication during each day.
